



This year, the State of Minnesota has elected to hold a Presidential Primary Election. This election will be held Tuesday, March 3, 2020. Minnesota will be one of 14 states participating in this election, which is also known as "Super Tuesday". This is the first Presidential Primary Election held in Minnesota since 1992. In addition to the Presidential Primary Election there will be a Primary Election on Tuesday, August 11, 2020 and the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

NEW POLLING LOCATION for NYA CITY RESIDENTS

There is a new polling place for the 2020 elections. All residents that live within Norwood Young America city limits will vote at NYA City Hall, located at 310 Elm Street West. Minnesota residents can also vote by absentee ballot. Absentee ballots for anyone that lives within Carver County, can be obtained at the Carver County Government Center at 600 East 4th Street, Chaska, MN 55318.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

To verify that you are registered to vote, or if you have moved since the last time that you voted, go to: <https://www.sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/register-to-vote/>. You can also register at the polling location with a valid Minnesota Driver's License or a Minnesota Identification Card. In order to vote, you must be a U.S. citizen, be at least 18 years of age on the election date, and not incarcerated, on parole, or on probation as part of a felony conviction sentence.

WHAT IS ON THE BALLOT?

The Presidential Primary Election will have the names of the candidates that are running for the Office of the President. There will not be any local or state offices on the ballot. When you arrive at the polling place, you must tell the election judge which major party ballot that you want. The party you choose will not be public information, though it will be available to each major party. Above are the sample ballots, or you can see them at <https://myballotmn.sos.state.mn.us/>.
