## **Senior Survey Questions**

The Senior Advisory Commission and Carver County conducted a senior survey in June 2019. Attached are the results of that survey. It concentrated on housing, transportation, and quality of life questions. The new senior survey topics include housing, transportation, quality of life, communication methods and education/socializing. Results from both survey's will be compared and used to quantify:

- Current housing situation and how it has changed in two years
- Transportation needs and City bus service suggestions
- Senior needs for food resources, home service, etc.
- Feedback on the Senior Buddy Program and if the need is worth pursing
- Means of senior communication for future assistance, announcements, advertising
- Education opportunities

Commissioners are asked to review the 2019 survey. Staff will provide preliminary feedback for the 2021 survey at the April Senior Advisory meeting. The final report will be presented at the May meeting.
