**1. Call meeting to order**

Kroells called the meeting to order at 9am.

**2. Pledge of Allegiance**

**Monitor and expand housing options for seniors -**

**5.1 Senior Residence Updates**

**a. Harbor / Haven**

Hilgers shared there are 6 open apts in the Harbor, 6 in the Haven and Reflections is full. Hilgers shared they are hiring for RA's and dining assistants and having open interviews on June 21. Training can all be done on site. They are also looking for volunteers. Activities included a Peony Presentation and a Father's Day Car Show.

**b. Peace Villa**

Simmons shared the construction project will start in July with completion being February. Residents had a meeting with Schmitz for an update on the entire construction project. Williams commented there is 100% occupancy.

**c. Oak Grove**

Slavik shared they have all but one apartment rented which is a 2 bedroom/one den, 1,443 sf for \$1530/month. They recently had a Bingo event with about 30 people in attendance. COVID Carver Co Public Health booster clinic is on Tuesday at Oak Grove.

**5.2 City Bus Update**

**5.2.1 Shopping Trips -**

Hallquist shared that the shopping trips going well. Music in the Park had only two passengers with multiple attempts at each senior facility location. Hallquist reported the bus is not being utilized.

**5.2.2 "Out & About" Trips**

Hallquist reported both June trips were cancelled due to lack of participation. This could be because people are getting their rides from other means.

**5.3 Carver County Public Health**

Hallquist read Plummer's email that Public Health will be offering COVID vaccine boosters at senior housing in Chaska on June 16 and Oak Grove and Crossings (Waconia) on June 21.

**5.4 Carver County Sheriff's Department**

Voigt introduced new Carver County Deputy Christine who came from Wright County. No activities going on in NYA.
