Karen Schambour with CAP Agency gave a presentation on the Meals On Wheels program. Seniors can register for hot or cold meals to be delivered M-F. Four local churches help with the distribution. A donation of \$5 is suggested for the meal, however, not required. Information will be provided in the next city newsletter.

5.1 Senior Residence Updates

a. Harbor / Haven

Hallquist shared information from an email from Hilgers; There are 4 open apts in the Harbor with 1 reserved, 5 in the Haven with 1 reserved, and Reflections is full. There are multiple positions available. All positions are posted on the Ecumen website under Career Opportunities.

b. Peace Villa

Schmitz reported that their occupancy is full with a growing waiting list of up to 9-12 months. PV will be celebrating 45 year anniversary this coming fall. The building will be installed with MetroNet for \$75/mo for all residents. Construction is aimed to be done Feb 3, 2023.

c. Oak Grove

Slavik shared via email that there is a 1 den and a 2 plus den available. The OG community had a root beer float social hour and is planning a National Night Out luncheon.
