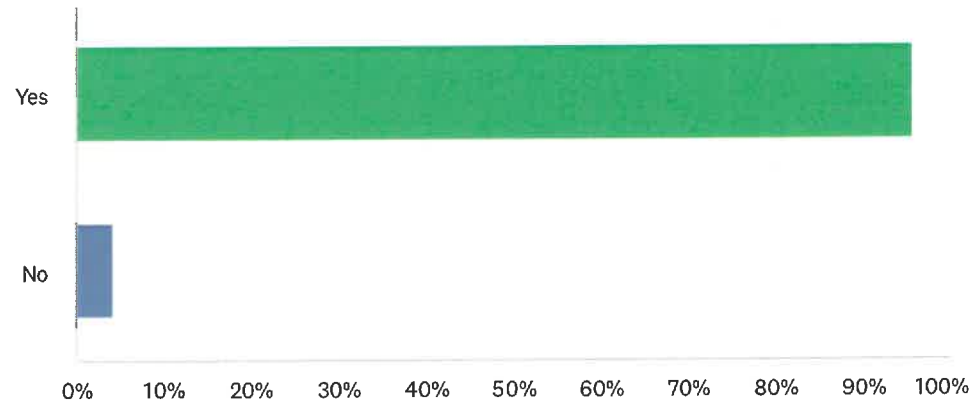

Q1 Are you a resident of Norwood Young America?

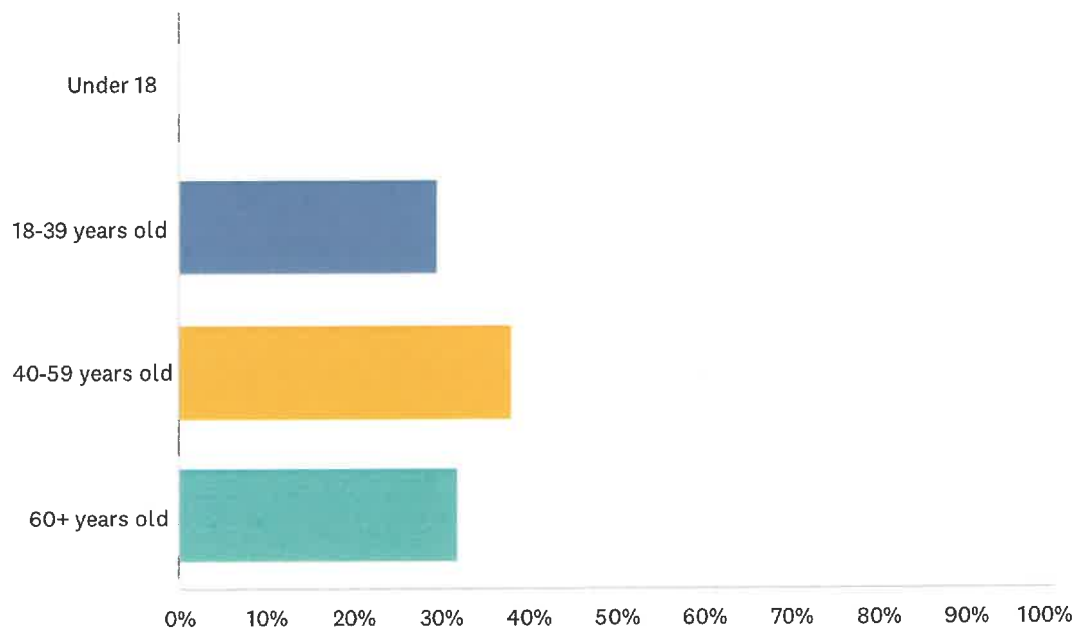

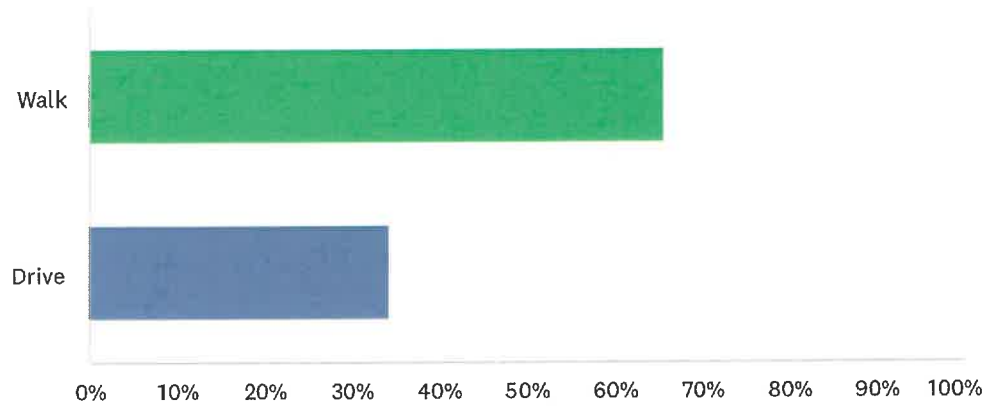

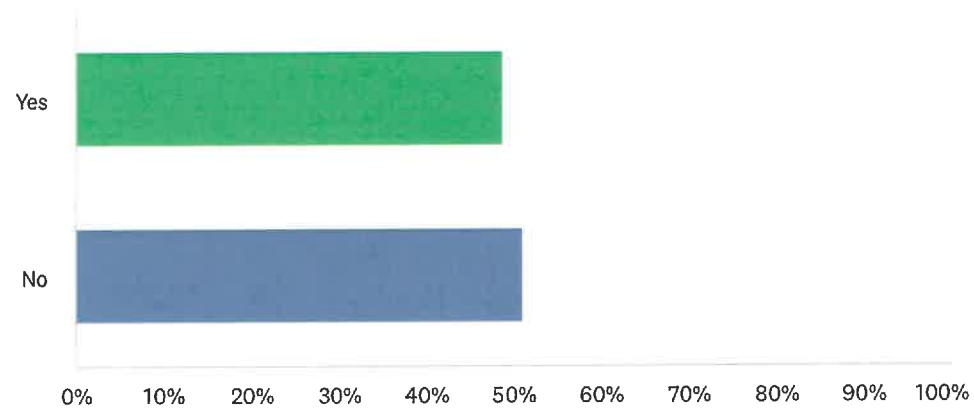

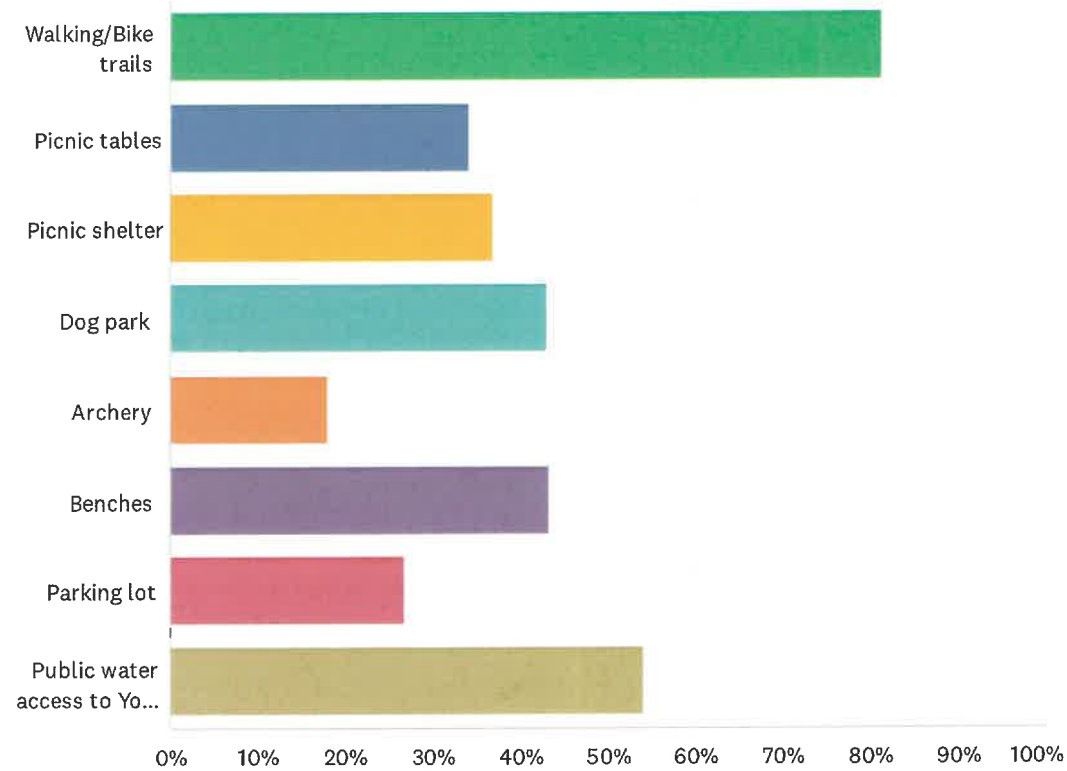

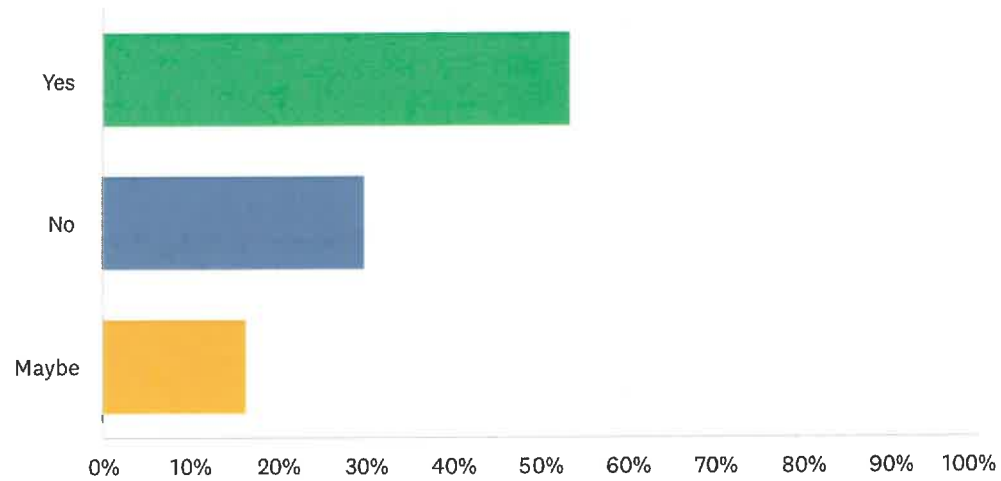

Q7 If you have a dog, would you utilize a dog park?

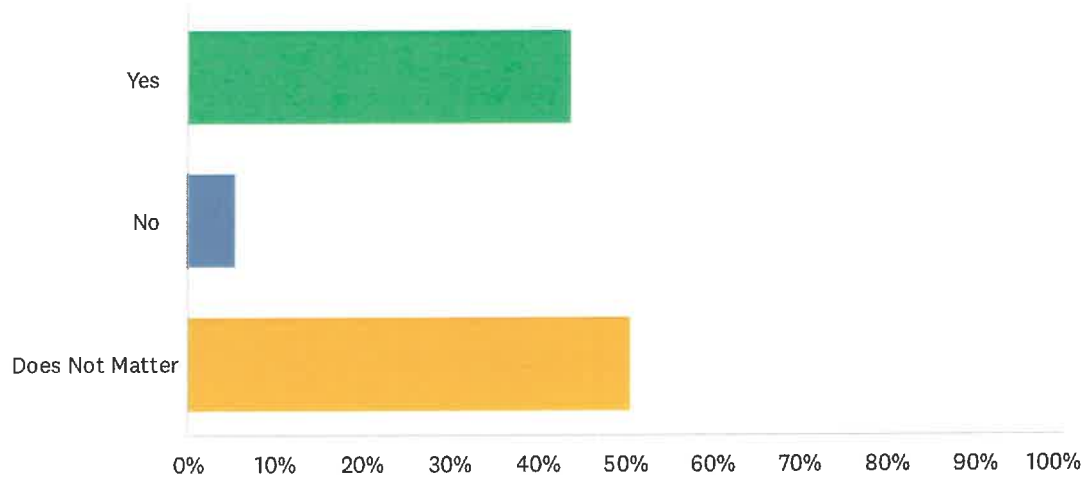

Q8 If you have a dog, do you prefer the smaller dogs to be separated from the larger dogs?

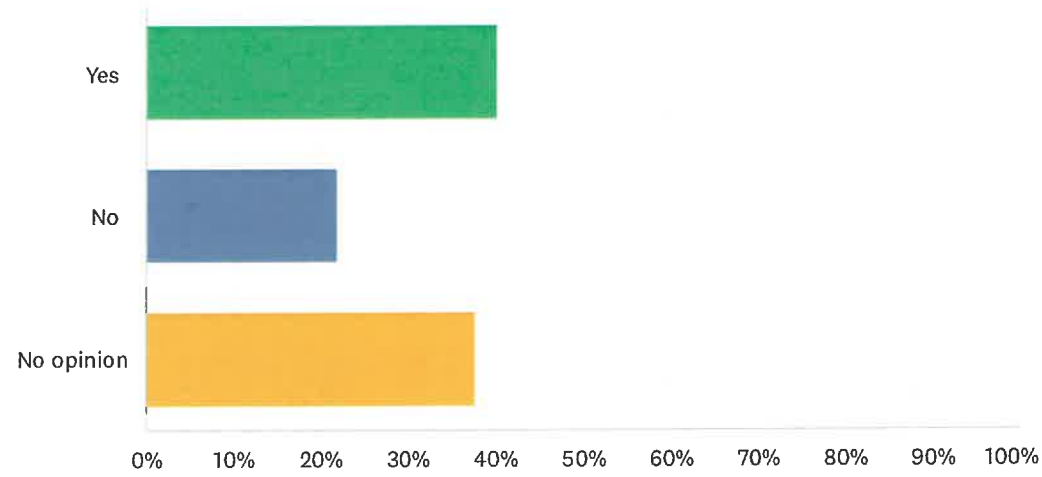

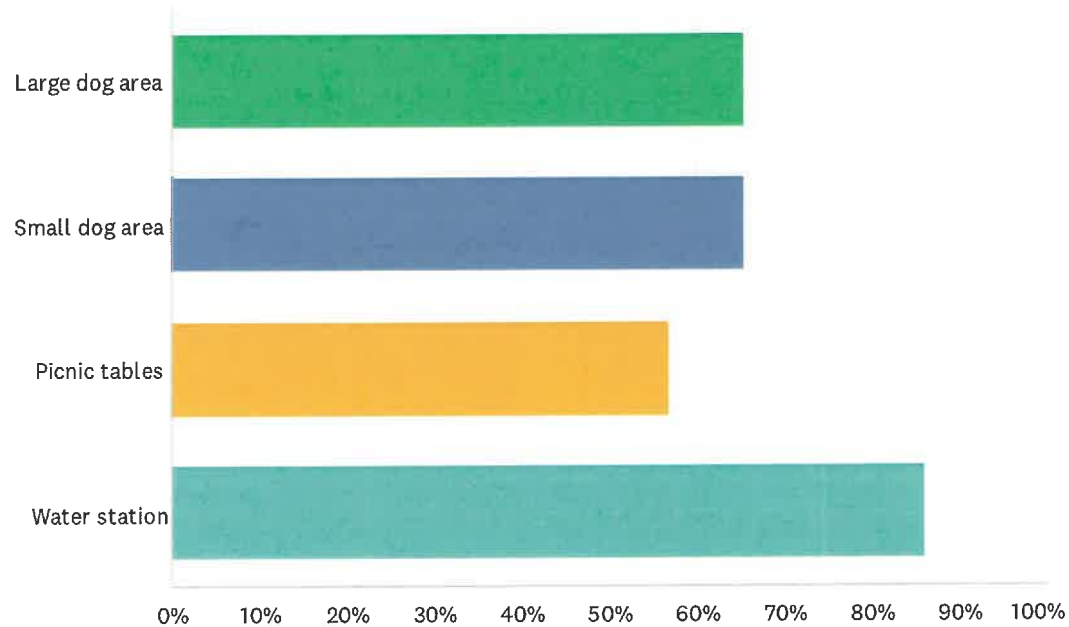

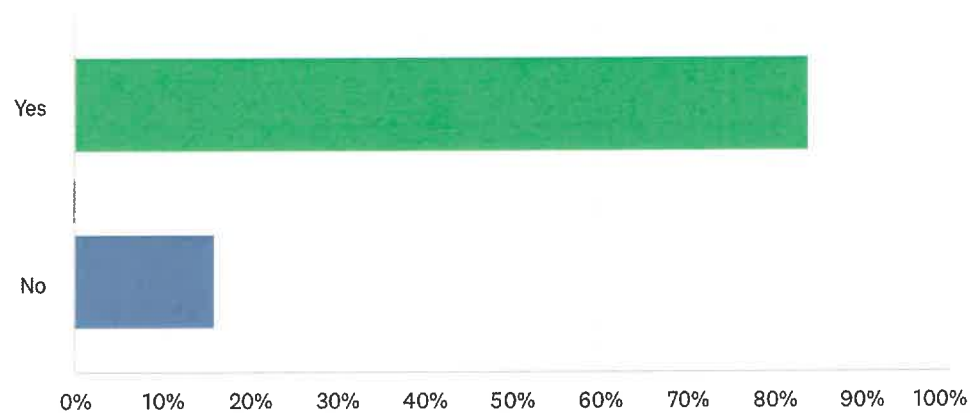

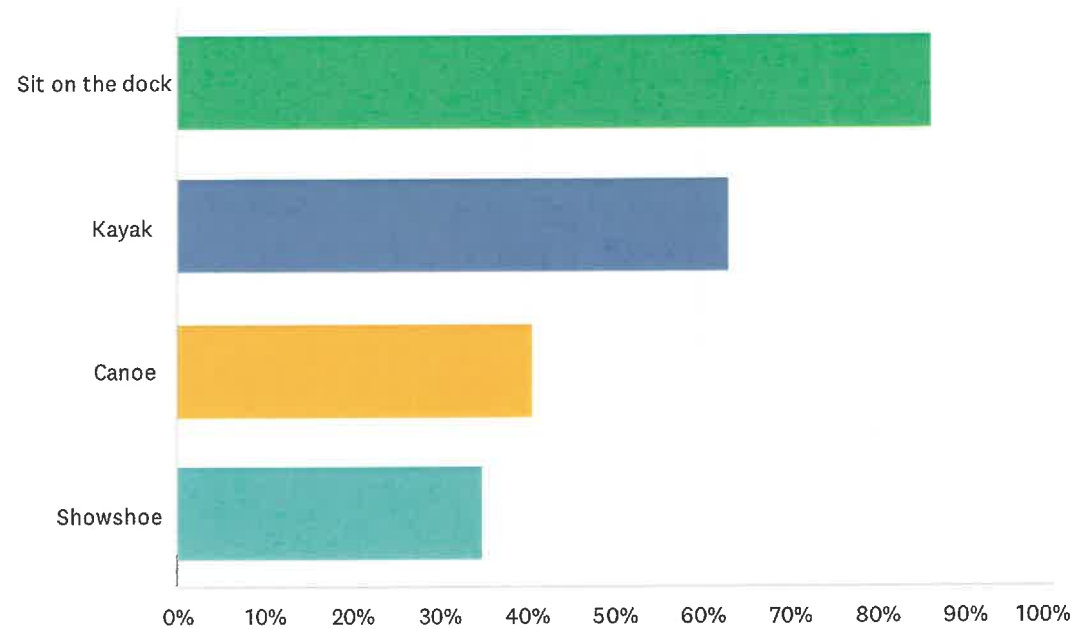
