5.1 Senior Residence Updates

### a. Harbor / Haven

Hilgers shared the Harbor has 4 open (1 reserved) apartments, Haven 5 open (1 reserved), Reflections is full. There are multiple positions available including residence coordinator and CNA positions. They are still following CDA guidelines. Harbor/Haven is up for three categories in the Best of Carver County.

### b. Peace Villa

Schmitz reported that their occupancy is full. They are also up for Best of Carver County. Construction has started. They are looking at going to a fob system.

#### c. Oak Grove

Slavik shared via email that there is a 1 plus den and a 2 plus den available. National Night Out luncheon event was a success with S&S Chicken from New Prague doing the catering at \$8/meal. They also donated 131 pounds of food to the food shelf. Slavik will have office hours on Tues/Thurs and remote hours on M/W/F. Slavik mentioned they are looking for speakers to bring in. Hallquist mentioned that Southern MN Regional Legal Services will have a speaker at the next Senior Advisory meeting in Sept. They have other programs to present as well.

Plummer shared that she has been helping at the food distributions within Carver County. She said Wright County is using SHIP funds to do a Falls Prevention referral program that she will investigate. Plummer shared that Trellis has programs for seniors and AARP has a new Home Fit Guide.

5.4 Carver County Sheriff's Department

Voigt reported that fraud/scams are back in the area. No one should give personal information via their phone or email. Carver County is cracking down on disturbed driving – there have been 21 fatalities since 2021 due to speed, DWI, and cellphones.
